The ASLA 2016 Annual Meeting and EXPO, held in New Orleans from October 21-24th, is the largest gathering of landscape architecture professionals and students in the world. This year's theme 'explores a celebration of place.'

This year, West 8 New York Principal-in-Charge, [Claire Agre](#) presents an education session on Saturday **October 22nd** entitled "Great Landscapes on Wet Sites: Understanding and Managing High Water Tables."

Claire will act as moderator for three expert panelists Jeffrey L. Bruce, President, [Jeffrey L. Bruce & Company LLC](#); Barrett L. Kays Senior Soil, Hydrologic, Groundwater Scientist & Landscape Architect, [Landis](#); and Robert Pine, Principal, [Pine & Swallow Environmental](#).

Coastal, waterfront, floodplain, urban disturbed, and clay upland soils often have a shallow water table that impacts the soils and plants. This hour and half educational session, which runs from **11.00am to 12.30PM**, will explore factors that cause a high water table, and examine the variety of approaches that each of the speakers have used to monitor, evaluate, and manage dynamic water table fluctuations on major landscape architectural projects.
