

South of Moulon Park, lies one of the main squares of the campus, les Carré des Sciences. The square is an extension of the forecourt of the CentraleSupélec buildings and will become a pivotal gathering place to host events related to campus life. The square will connect through to the Park and the iconic 'Point F' pavilion, linking to Joliot-Curie Street and opening out onto the wooded edge of the park plateau.

Construction of Moulon Park and Carré des Sciences is slated to begin in mid-2016 and will be delivered in phases between summer 2017 and spring 2018.
