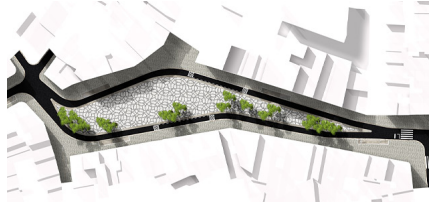
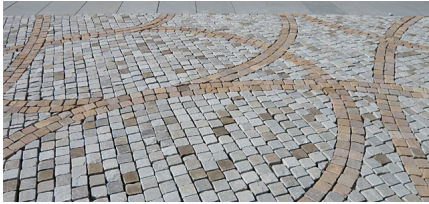


FALCONPLEIN
