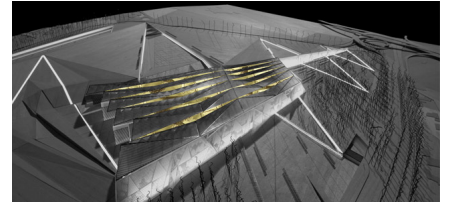
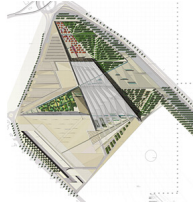


# GRAND EGYPTIAN MUSEUM PARK
